
Enjoy views of the waterfalls from various viewing platforms, including the **FIVE-STORY OBSERVATION TOWER**.

With elevator access, the panorama is available to all. The adjoining gift shop, the city's largest for souvenirs, invites visitors to bring home a piece of their trip, from postcards and magnets to locally inspired keepsakes. Blending hospitality, history, and scenery, the Center is the perfect introduction to Sioux Falls. 
## PLENTY FOR EVERYBODY



**GREAT BEAR RECREATION PARK** is on a mission to provide fun and meaningful experiences all year long. And it does! When the snow starts falling, bundle up and break out your gear for downhill skiing, snowboarding, snowshoeing, cross-country skiing, and—a definite favorite—snow tubing! When the temperature starts rising, the 7-mile trail system leads hikers, bikers, and runners on a variety of nature experiences from ADA-rated strolls to demanding terrain excursions.

**Looking to shred?** Ten miles of singletrack bike-optimized trails are being developed in Great Bear—with the first 4 miles now open! Professionally built, the trails provide straightforward cross-country riding and more challenging downhill trips. ### JACOBSON PLAZA AT THE FALLS

Named after the Garry and Dianne Jacobson family—who were major supporters of the project's development—Jacobson Plaza officially opened to the public in June 2025. Thanks to the Jacobson family and a number of other significant contributions, this underutilized green space is now an all-season destination for people and pets of all ages and abilities. The park is free to enter and is home to some of the biggest and most unique attractions in the region.

The skate ribbon is built for year-round recreation with refrigerated ice in the winter months and concrete in the warm seasons. **Did someone say bumper cars?!**


### CHERAPA PLACE

Built on the site of the former Zip Feed Mill—an industrial area on the east bank of the Big Sioux River—the initial Cherapa Place building opened in 2007 and was the first LEED Gold Certified project in the state. In 2021, a major expansion grew the site to four mixed-use buildings with apartments and retail. Sitting squarely alongside the Big Sioux River and the Arc of Dreams, you can dine with a view at any of the area's fun restaurant offerings.



### THE STEEL DISTRICT

This large-scale downtown development sits on seven acres of land once occupied by Sioux Steel Co. The project began in August 2021 and took more than three years to complete. As one of the latest urban neighborhoods developed in Sioux Falls, The Steel District is home to The Canopy by Hilton hotel, various living options, offices, retail, and exciting new restaurants.



### THE CATLIN HOTEL

A classic example of making what's old(er), new again. Formerly the Hilton Garden Inn, the hotel started its grand transformation in early 2025. When renovations are complete, the hotel will rebrand to The Catlin Hotel and be part of Hilton's Tapestry Collection. 


## USD – SIOUX FALLS

Sioux Falls is home to powerful landmarks that honor the courage, sacrifice, and service of America's military veterans.



Step into history at the **Battleship South Dakota Memorial**, where the massive concrete outline of World War II's most-decorated battleship helps visitors grasp the scale of this legendary vessel. From 1942 to 1945, the USS South Dakota and its crew fought in every major battle in the Pacific. Inside the museum—soon to be expanded—you'll find artifacts from life at sea and stories of bravery, including those who gave the ultimate sacrifice.



Nearby, the 22-acre **Veterans' Memorial Park** stands on the grounds of a former World War II Army Air Corps training base. Flags, striking sculptures, a memorial wall, and the Medal of Honor Garden create a place of remembrance. Winding paths along Covell Lake, shaded benches, and an amphitheater invite quiet reflection and community gatherings alike.



Just north of the city, the **South Dakota Veterans Cemetery**, established in 2021, stretches across 60 rolling acres. As the first federally funded, state-owned, and state-operated cemetery in South Dakota, it provides a solemn and lasting tribute to those who served.

Together, these sites offer moving opportunities to honor veterans, reflect on their sacrifices, and connect with the stories that shaped our nation.



### ACT I: SETTING THE STAGE

On March 2, 1926, the doors to the State Theatre opened and welcomed the community to escape everyday life and be entertained with silent films and vaudeville acts. A landmark project for Twin Cities cinema entrepreneurs M.L. Finkelstein and I.H. Ruben, the movie palace featured a grand auditorium, ornate architectural details, and a brilliant marquee that illuminated the downtown skyline, and a Wurlitzer Organ that took 6 weeks to install and cost \$25,000. The State originally seated 1,634 guests, though the seats were quite different from the comfortable recliners audiences enjoy today.

**DID YOU KNOW?** When the State Theatre opened, it was the largest theatre in South Dakota—and it used more electrical current than a town of 2,500 people!

### ACT II: THE RISE AND DECLINE

For decades, the State Theatre thrived as the crown jewel of downtown Sioux Falls. In 1956, it even hosted the world premiere of *The Last Hunt*, a major motion picture starring Stewart Granger, Russ Tamblyn, and Venetia Stevenson—each of whom attended the event. However, as time went on, many historic movie palaces across the country were demolished or repurposed into parking lots and commercial spaces. The State was fortunate not to meet the same fate, but it ultimately closed its doors in June of 1990.

### ACT III: THE SHOW MUST GO ON

Never underestimate the power of a community determined to preserve a cherished landmark. In 2005, a group of passionate Sioux Falls residents formed the Sioux Falls State Theatre Company, a 501(c)(3) nonprofit, to save the building and restore it to its original grandeur. Significant donations and unwavering support kept the project moving, but it would ultimately take nearly 30 years of fundraising, passion, and perseverance before the State Theatre welcomed audiences once again.

On December 11, 2020, the State Theatre reopened to the public with a perfectly fitting screening of *White Christmas*. However, the restoration is not yet complete. Renovations are still needed to open the second floor and balcony—work that will increase seating capacity and return even more of the theatre's historic spaces to the community that has championed it for decades.

In 2026, the State Theatre will celebrate its 100th birthday. And now, thanks to the dedication of many, you are invited to experience a living piece of history—one that continues to shine because this community never stopped believing in it.



The Mezzanine overlooking the lobby showcases skylights, seating areas, a business center, a fitness center, Josiah's Library and Hattie's Parlour.




